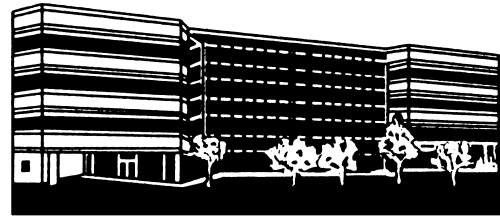

The **Class of 1963** will be the featured class, celebrating in conjunction with Homecoming their Big 5 0! They are having a dinner/program

at Dakes Restaurant in Borger on Saturday evening and also have the Borger Ambassador Inn conference room reserved for Friday. They also will be participating in the Saturday morning HC activities. **Kelly Caufield** and **Virginia Pirtle** are heading up the reunion effort. Other classes having special 5-year interval reunions *that we are aware of* are the **Classes of '53** (still in the planning stages), **'73 (ditto)**, and **'58**. **The Class of 1958** is having a steak cookout at Don Creacy's home in Fritch on Saturday at 7:00 pm, to which the 1955-1961 Classes are invited to attend. However, Don's chuckwagon setup can only feed a maximum of 130 people, and top priority goes of course to the *number* of 1958 Class members plus their spouses who show up. **Dues** are still \$7 (we are able once again to hold them there despite our yearly declining active membership and increasing postal and printing costs). \$10 covers you and your spouse, if both are Phillips exes. Please be aware that you do not join, but are automatically a member of the Alumni Association by virtue of being an ex, and be mindful that your dues are what keep your Association going and able to put on Homecoming events, send out letters, maintain the Heritage Center, and provide the Internet web site.
