

Attention Golfers! All interested Hawks, spouses, dates, or family members are invited to play at the Big Blackhawk Golf Scramble at the **Borger Municipal Golf Course (formerly the Phillips Country Club)** located in north Borger. Tee-off time is Friday, July 14, 9:00 a.m. sharp. Entry fee is \$30 per person. Several local sponsors (many are exes) will again donate money for prizes, which keeps the entry fee to a minimum. Please give them your business while in Borger (see attached ads). So all you golfers, please fill out the golf entry form and return.

A horseshoe tournament will be held Saturday 3:00 p.m. at the Borger Horseshoe Club site located just north of the Borger football field right

off Bulldog Ave. Entry fee will be **\$5** per person. Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. Please fill out the horseshoe entry form and return. You may choose and indicate your own partner (another Phillips ex or a family member); otherwise you will be assigned a partner at the tournament. **Folks- \$5 is a bargain!!** Unlike golf, you don't have to play regularly to compete. Don't worry- you won't be competing with pros. If you won't play, at least please come and watch. Bathrooms, benches, water, and shade available.

The **Class of 1967** will be the featured class, celebrating in conjunction with Homecoming their Big 50! They are having a "meet and greet" get-together at the meeting room of the Hampton Inn in Borger on Friday afternoon and a dinner that evening at a place yet to be confirmed. **Les Skinner and Jan Railsback** are heading up the reunion effort. The **Class of 1972** is having a Friday evening social and a Saturday evening meal, both at **Steve Williams' brewery** in Borger. The **Class of 1957** will be celebrating their 60th, but no specific plans have been made to date. The **Class of 1977** reportedly may be trying to put some plans together to meet, but it's uncertain at this time. All four classes also will be participating in the Saturday HC activities. As of now, we are not aware of any other classes who may be celebrating a 5-year (or any-year) interval class reunion. Let us know if your class is planning a reunion.

At the Saturday morning function, **Les Skinner('67)** will be our featured speaker. There will be the customary drawings for (1) a wool Blackhawk blanket for some dues-paying ex, and (2) a 50-year reunion blanket for some attending **Class of 1967** ex. There will also be drawings for 3 cash give-aways. Blackhawk umbrellas will be for sale at **\$20** each. After the program, a fajita and enchilada buffet meal will be served, catered by **The Plaza** of Borger (Lefty's has closed). The price will be **\$15 that you will pay right before eating. Please let us know on the Information Form that you return whether you plan to eat with us.** If you indicate that you are, and have to cancel later, please let us know! Our food caterers need a fairly accurate head count in order to know how much food to prepare.

If at all possible, the noted and very popular Amarillo News Globe featured columnist, Jon Mark Beilue, will attend our Saturday morning program and be doing a follow-up article on our Homecoming for the newspaper.

Information Form: Even if you do not plan to come this July or can't send in any dues, please fill out the form (indicating the total amount of money sent, if any is enclosed), detach, and mail to us rightaway. We want to make a special appeal to the exes who either never or very seldom respond to this letter year in and year out. It is very important that your information we have on hand be current, **especially your E-mail address.** Over 20% of the Email addresses for most classes bounce when we send out Emails to the classes. It will only take you just a few minutes to tend to this matter now and have it out of your hair...or otherwise it will be out of sight, out of mind. **Dues** are still **\$7** (we are able once again to hold them there despite our yearly declining active membership and increasing postal and printing costs). **\$10** covers you and your spouse, if both are Phillips exes. Please be

mindful that your dues (and donations) are what keep your Association going and able to put on Homecomings, send out letters, maintain the Heritage Center, provide/maintain the Internet web site, and give away prizes and tokens. Your annual dues also give you a chance to win an attractive Blackhawk wool blanket and keep you on the current year's mailout list for the fall alumni newsletter, "The Blackhawk Spirit", Edition No. 22 coming up.

Class address listings cost \$1.50 each and the **deceased list is \$2.00**. An 8½" X 11" copy of an old **map of Phillips is \$1.50**. The listings you order will not be mailed out until late May to ensure that you have the benefit of the latest exes contact information. Those wishing to contribute an extra **\$100 or more** will have their name etched on a special donor plaque displayed at the Heritage Center; however, no one, by any means, is discouraged from donating *any amount less than \$100*, it will be put to good use no matter the amount. You may designate (1) General Use, (2) the Heritage Center, or (3) the Scholarship Fund of your choice. You also may make your donation in memory of someone dear to you. This year, our focus is on funding our new scholarship to honor Helen Bisbee who taught grade school music and junior high Spanish for over 30 years ... although you can still donate to the established Creel, Kimmins, Johnson, Adkins, Walker, Robbins, Hayes, Hubbard, Williams Brothers, Forbus, Gunter, George, and Flanders Scholarship Funds. We welcome your donations!! These perennial scholarships, and the Heritage Center, are our only legacy now and perpetuate the name of Phillips. Moreover they help a

needy, usually local, student continue his/her education, each currently providing \$1 000/year. So a \$10,000 endowment scholarship only takes ten years to pay for itself, assuming that FPC can continue a robust 10% rate of return.

Attention! We still have a big surplus of spare **high school, junior high, and elementary school annuals** for most of the classes that we want to give away (yep, for free!). We need to free up needed storage space. If you want an annual(s) and we have one available, you may pick it up at the Heritage Center at Homecoming anytime between the end of the Saturday morning program and 3:00 p.m. First come, first served.


