Tee-off time is Friday, July 13, 9:00 a.m. sharp. Entry fee is \$30 per person. Several local sponsors (many are exes) will again donate money for prizes, which keeps the entry fee to a minimum. Please give them your business while in Borger (see attached ads). So all you golfers, please fill out the golf entry form and return. Please sign up with us rather than paying at the Club.

A **horseshoe tournament** will be held Saturday 3:00 p.m. at the Borger Horseshoe Club site located just north of the Borger football

field right off Bulldog Ave. Entry fee will be \$5 per person. Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. Only exes and family members are permitted to sign up to play. Please fill out the horseshoe entry form and return ASAP. No last-minute entries will be accepted. One change - this year all participants will draw for partners. Folks - \$5 is a bargain!! 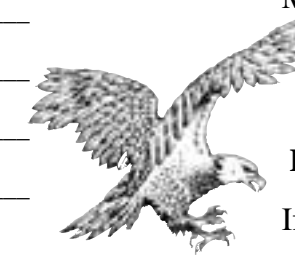
