Attention Golfers! All interested Hawks, spouses, dates, or family members are invited to play at the Big Blackhawk Golf Scramble at the Borger Municipal Golf Course (formerly the Phillips Country Club) located in north Borger. Tee-off time is Friday, July 12, 9:00 a.m. sharp. Entry fee is \$30 per person. Several local sponsors (many are exes) will again donate money for prizes, which keeps the entry fee to a minimum. Please give them your business while in Borger (see attached ads). So all you golfers, please fill out the golf entry form and return it along with your entry fee to us, i.e., we prefer you prepay.

A horseshoe tournament will be held Saturday 3:00 p.m. at the Borger Horseshoe Club site located just north of the Borger football field right off Bulldog Ave. Entry fee will be \$5 per person. Please fill out the horseshoe entry form and return ASAP. If you recall, the tournament

was rained out last year. So if you paid your \$5 last year, you are already paid up (but you can always pay again and increase the prize pot), but please still send your completed form in to us. Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winning pairs. Only exes and family members are permitted to sign up to play. No last-minute entries will be accepted. One change - this year all participants will draw for partners. Folks, \$5 is a bargain!! If you won't play, at least please come and watch. Bathrooms, benches, water, and shade available. And a McDonalds, Braums, and Sonic are close by.

There is possibly a chance of a change in venue for the Friday evening mixer which tentatively will be held at the usual site. If so, we'll notify you of the new place via Facebook or email or our website.

The Class of 1964 is having a mini-reunion on April 10 in San Antonio, and is also planning on convening in Borger at Homecoming to celebrate their 55th. Any questions, call **Sharon Flinn** at (512)789-6152. All four classes also will be participating in the Saturday HC activities.

At the Saturday morning function, **Demetra "Dede" Prather**, a former head volleyball coach who coached at PHS from 1968-1971 and led the lady Blackhawks to two state championships, will be our featured speaker. This will be only her second appearance at Homecoming. So we want to especially encourage all you former volleyball players who played under her to make a special effort to attend, as Demetra is making a special effort to attend herself. You players will be briefly presented and recognized at the morning meeting. There will be the customary drawings for (1) a wool Blackhawk blanket for some dues-paying ex, and (2) a 50-year reunion blanket for some attending Class of 1969 ex. There will also be drawings for 3 cash give-aways. After the program, a BBQ buffet meal will be served, catered by **Dyers BBQ** of Amarillo. The price will be \$10 that you will pay right before eating. Please let us know ASAP on the Information Form you return whether you plan to eat with us. And keep us informed if you later change your mind. Dyers needs a fairly accurate head count (that we have to commit to) in order to know how much food to prepare.

Information Form: Even if you do not plan to come this July or can't send in any dues, please fill out the form (indicating the total amount of money sent, if any is enclosed), detach, and mail to us rightaway. *We want to make a special appeal to the exes who either never or very seldom respond to this letter year in and year out.* It is very important that your information we have on hand be current, *especially your Email address.* Over 20% of the Email addresses for most classes bounce when we send out Emails to the classes. It will only take you just a few minutes to tend

to this matter now and have it out of your hair...or otherwise the form will be out of sight, out of mind. **Dues** are still \$7 (we are able once again to hold them there despite our yearly declining active membership and increasing postal and printing costs). **\$10** covers you and your spouse, if both are Phillips exes. Please be mindful that **your dues and especially your donations are what keep your Association going** and able to put on Homecomings, send out letters, maintain the Heritage Center, provide/maintain the Internet web site, and give away prizes and tokens.
